

2020 Summer Camp “Restart Sailing”



In order to comply with city, county, and state ordinances regarding social distancing and occupancy, as well as to ensure the safety of the sailors and staff - we will be adjusting the summer camp program activities as following:

- **Before Sailing**
 - Ensure sailor is dressed appropriately for camp before arriving at the club
 - Let the Sailing Director know if there is to be an early pickup that day
 - Please respect these protocols as we reserve the right to deny anybody participation in camp if they actively do not comply with these protocols we have outlined.
- **On Land**
 - Face coverings are to be worn at all times on land - Buff/Face Shields are acceptable
 - We will be minimizing time on land to the bare minimum - only one group will be eating lunch on property at a time
 - Instruction will happen outside, please be prepared to have your sailor be outside for extended periods of time.
 - All sailors must wear sun-protective clothing to the maximum extent
 - While on property social distancing is required
 - Docks are marked with boat placement in appropriate intervals, coaches will expedite the launching process
 - Kids are not allowed upstairs, even if they are members. Exception being emergencies or very inclement weather.
 - We will be using the Buddy System - each sailor has one companion that they can congregate and sail with
 - Any 'hanging out' must be done off-premises
 - Gate will be managed and temperatures will be checked - any sailor with a temperature above 99 degrees will be asked to stay home.
 - Pickup/Dropoff will be done outside the gate, coming through is reserved for club members only.
 - Parents are asked to remain in their car, coaches will ensure sailors are prepared for pickup
- **Out At Sea**
 - Kids will not ride on coachboats, barring emergencies that happen out on the water
 - If your sailor is not feeling well, or is not feeling ready for sailing, they should stay home.
 - Sailing time will be managed and the idea is to keep the kids actively out on the water as much as possible. Groups will be kept separate as much as possible.
 - In case of inclement weather, the smaller kids will go to the veranda upstairs and the older kids will stay downstairs.
 - In order to save time, sailors will sail close to shore within .6 nautical miles of CGSC to the south of Brennan Channel
 - No more than 2 sailors to a boat, maximum.
- **Scheduling**
 - If you know ahead of time that you are picking up your sailor early, please let the Sailing Director know asap.
 - If you are picking up your sailor early for an unexpected reason, reach out to the Sailing Director FIRST, then the Lead Coach.
- **Considerations**
 - We ask that all parents respect social distancing guidelines and actively participate in these protocols as we wish to ensure a smooth summer and transition into the Fall.

These protocols were decided on by the Board and the Administration, and are in step with government guidelines and guidance. Please keep in mind that in order to fulfill the terms of our Lease with the City of Miami, and continue to operate, we must fulfill social distancing guidelines and these protocols along with any other requirements by CGSC Administration.

We know that these are tough times but only together can we ensure a smooth as possible transition into the summer and let the kids have a chance to sail. We thank you for your patience and understanding, there is still much sailing to be done.
